**2016 COMPOST PROGRAM  
 PICK UP COMMENCES MAY 16, 2016**

At the January 9, 2016 Council Budget Meeting, Council approved the 2016 Compost Program. **This is a user pay program.**

**For those residents who took part in the program in 2015**, the program will cost you \$36.00 for the year 2016. You may elect to have this put on your utility bills or pay in full in one lump payment.

**For residents new to the program**, you will need to come into the Town of Rimbey Administration Office to sign up for the program. You will be required to purchase an 80 litre bin (maximum of 2 bins) at a cost of \$11.00 each plus GST, for grass/compost from the Town of Rimbey.

**Costs of the Program to you the resident:** Annual Cost of \$36.00 averaged over 12 months is \$3.00 per month on your utility bills, or payable in one lump sum payment, plus \$11.00 per 80 litre bin purchased from the Town of Rimbey (if you have not already purchased them from us). If you start part way through the year, the cost is still \$36.00. **This is not negotiable.**

If the residence is a rental property, the homeowner, must also sign the registration form as it may be an addition to their previously signed utility rental agreement.

**\*\*\*WATER RESTRICTION NOTICE\*\*\***

The Town will provide proper and responsible conservation of its most important resource by implementing the following water restrictions as authorized in Sections 2.10 and 2.11 of Bylaw 776/05.

**The watering of lawns and gardens will be restricted on a continuing basis:**

1.1 Occupants or owners of even numbered addresses will be permitted to water on calendar days of the months ending in even numbers;

1.2 Occupants or owners of odd numbered addresses will be permitted to water on calendar days of the months ending in odd numbers.

1.3 In the case of a water shortage caused by weather conditions, mechanical reasons or otherwise, the Town Manager has the authority to set limitations on rationing of water. If, in the opinion of the Town Manager and/or Town Foreman, during such water shortages, any user is abusing his water privileges, the Town Manager may authorize services to said premises to be temporarily suspended. The period of suspension shall be determined by the Town Manager, or in the absence of the Town Manager, the Town Foreman.

**\*\*\* TOWN HYDRANT FLUSHING \*\*\***

The water odd and even restrictions are for residents; however, not for the Town of Rimbey regarding hydrant flushing. Each hydrant requires 500 gallons of water to flush out the bio-solids from the hydrants which move through the sewer system to be treated. The Town cannot save the hydrant water flush as it is against Alberta Environment Regulations

The purpose of the flushing is to make sure that the valves are working for the Fire Service. We cannot use the excuse that we didn't know the hydrant wasn't working. Our hydrants are all on a program and are flushed according to that program. We typically do 125 hydrants per year, which includes cleaning out the valves from debris and making sure they work.

Hydrants are for your safety and to protect infrastructure.
