Family Violence Prevention Month

The Community Wellness Association has identified Family Violence Prevention as one of its 4 primary goals. They have advised:

- ◆ *All Canadians pay a steep price for violence against women. It's estimated that each year, Canadians collectively spend \$7.4 billion to deal with the aftermath of spousal violence alone, according to the Department of Justice. This figure includes immediate costs such as emergency room visits and related costs, such as loss of income. It also includes tangible costs such as funerals, and intangible costs such as pain and suffering.*
- ◆ *Half of all women in Canada have experienced at least one incident of physical or sexual violence since the age of 16.*
- ◆ *67% of Canadians say they have personally known at least one woman who has experienced physical or sexual abuse.*
- ◆ *Approximately every six days, a woman in Canada is killed by her intimate partner. Out of the 83 police reported intimate partners homicides in 2014, 67 of the victims—over 80%—were women.*
- ◆ *On any given night in Canada, 3,491 women and their 2,724 children sleep in shelters because it isn't safe at home.*
- ◆ *On any given night, about 300 women and children are turned away because shelters are already full.*
