**TOWN OF RIMBEY
TAX DISCOUNT BYLAW 871/11
PART II- PROCEDURES**

2) A discount of two percent (2%) of the **municipal portion** of the taxes shall be applied to the prepayment of property taxes in the months of January and February.

3) Discounts shall be processed on funds received up to and including the close of business on the last business day in February.

4) Discounts shall not be applied to pre-payment of local improvement levies.

SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT APPEAL BOARD

The successful applicant(s) must be a resident of the Town of Rimbey.

The applications will remain open until five public members have been appointed by Council.

A FRIENDLY REMINDER

(Traffic Bylaw 909/15 Sec 13.1)

All persons within the Town of Rimbey owning, controlling, or occupying property that adjoins any sidewalk shall remove or cause to be removed and cleared away all snow, ice, dirt, debris or other material from any sidewalk adapted to the use of pedestrians. Such removal shall be completed when the snow is 2.5 centimetres or greater within 48 hours from the time that the snow, ice, dirt, debris, or other material was formed or deposited there.

2017 COMPOST PROGRAM

At the November 19, 2016 Council 2017 Budget Meeting, Council approved the 2017 Compost Program. **This is a user pay program.**

For those residents who took part in the program in 2016, you have until February 28, 2017 to opt out of the program, should you determine you no longer wish to participate; otherwise the program will cost you \$36.00 for the year 2017. You may elect to have this put on your utility bills **OR** pay in full in one lump payment.

For residents new to the program, you will need to come into the Town of Rimbey Administration Office to sign up for the program. You will be required to purchase an 80 litre bin (maximum of 2 bins) at a cost of \$11.00 each plus GST, for grass/compost from the Town of Rimbey.

Costs of the Program to you the resident: Annual Cost of \$36.00 averaged over 12 months is \$3.00 per month on your utility bills, **OR** payable in one lump sum payment, plus \$11.00 per 80 litre bin purchased from the Town of Rimbey (if you have not already purchased them from us). **If you start part way through the year, the cost is still \$36.00. This is not negotiable.**

If the residence is a rental property, the homeowner, must also sign the registration form as it may be an addition to their previously signed utility rental agreement.
