



A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF RIMBEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO REPEAL BYLAW 338/79 A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF RIMBEY, BEING A SUNDAY BYLAW

WHEREAS

The Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000 Chapter M-26, permits a Town Council to repeal a bylaw; and

AND WHEREAS

On March 28, 1979, Council Enacted Bylaw 338/79 A By-Law of the Town of Rimbey, Being a Sunday Bylaw.

AND WHEREAS

The Supreme Court of Canada deemed the Lord's Day Act to be unconstitutional on April 24, 1985.

AND WHEREAS

Council believes the Town should not enforce nor mandate business hours on Sundays.

NOW
THEREFORE

The Council of the Town of Rimbey, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Bylaw 338/79 is hereby repealed.

This Bylaw comes into effect on the date of third and final reading.

READ a First Time in Council this 12 day of June 2017.


READ a Second Time in Council this 12 day of June 2017.

UNANIMOUSLY AGREED to present this Bylaw for Third and Final Reading.

READ a Third Time and Finally Passed this 12 day of June, 2017.
