Town of Rimbey Tax Penalty Bylaw 870/11 states:

Part II—Procedures

- 2) A penalty of twelve percent (12%) shall be applied to all current taxes owing at the close of business on July 31 of each year. Should July 31 not be a business day, the penalty shall not be applied until the close of the business on the following business day.
