This is to remind residents of their responsibility for removing snow from the sidewalks along their property, as per Town Bylaws. Safe sidewalks are very important, especially for the children, seniors and the disabled, and we thank you for your anticipated cooperation.

This is to advise local businesses that it is time to renew 2012 Business Licenses. A new Business License Bylaw is now in effect that changes the amount of the license fees including violations and penalties. The Town of Rimbey requires that all dogs owned within the municipal boundaries are required to be licensed and wearing a tag. Dog licenses are affordable and ensure that Animal Services can make every effort to reunite you with your pet if ever lost. 2012 licenses are available for purchase at the Town Office.

Tax Discount is available to residents who prepay any amount of their 2012 property taxes in the months of January and February will receive a 2% discount.

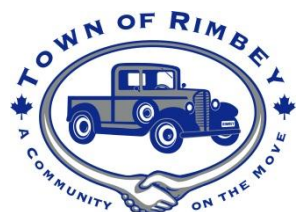
