



A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF RIMBEY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO REPEAL BYLAW 827/08 WHICH ENABLED COUNCIL TO PROVIDE PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVES FOR NEW COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS

The Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000 Chapter M-26, permits a Town Council to repeal a bylaw; and

AND WHEREAS

The Council of the Town of Rimbey on March 9, 2011 passed Motion #65/11 to repeal Bylaw 827/08 which enabled Council to provide property tax incentives for new commercial and industrial development;

NOW
THEREFORE

The Council of the Town of Rimbey, duly assembled, hereby enact as follows:

1. Bylaw 827/08 is hereby rescinded.

This By-Law comes into effect on the date of third and final reading.

READ a First Time in Council this 13 day of June 2016.

READ a Second Time in Council this 13 day of June 2016.
