****ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING BEYOND THE SCALE****

****Please keep all animals & small children in your vehicle at all times****

****For the safety of everyone, the speed limit within the landfill site is 20km/hr****

****Please be aware our scale is 10ft wide. Your loads CANNOT exceed the width of our scale****

****Please be prepared with your name & proper land location/street address/blue emergency sign #****

****If your garbage is loose, please be prepared to bag it on windy days****

Acceptable Materials

Main Pit ******ABSOLUTELY NO BURN BARREL OR FIREPLACE ASH******

****No dead animals, animal parts or farm animal feces****

All regular household garbage.

Small metals(nails,welding rods,staples etc.)

Small Appliances

Anything with a laminate cover(cabinets,countertops,laminate flooring etc.)

Non-Wood Building Materials(Drywall,Shingles,Insulation,Insulated metal panels,carpet & underlay etc)

All windows

Household speakers

Lamps, fans, indoor lighting

Household Furniture(couches,chairs,mattresses,patio furniture etc. Mixed material to be taken apart)

All Plastics

Fiberglass(tanks,toppers,sheeting etc.)

EMPTY Paint Cans

Yard waste(grass clippings, leaves etc)Bags must be cut open before dumping

Large feed bags must be cut open before being put in pit.

Plastic pipe/tubing no longer than 6 ft.

Silage Tarps and other large tarps/plastics (bale wrap, feed bags, large heavy poly & baling twine do not go into main pit. Should be rolled & tied.

Oil Building

CLEAN OIL ONLY!!!(No water or anti-freeze or it will be refused)

Used Oil, Oil Jugs, Oil Filters, Any empty plastic automotive fluid jugs.

No chemicals (heavy duty cleaners etc) you must hang on to them until the

Chemical Round ups in Rimbey & Ponoka which take place in May & September.

Herbicide Jugs* (Must be empty, triple rinsed, have an X cut in bottom, loose paper & lids removed, strung in strands of no more than 10 jugs.)*****

Wood Pit

WOOD ONLY (brush,branches, clean wood etc.)

Large stumps must be cut into burnable pieces.

No paper, dirt, insulation, laminates, shingles, cardboard, drywall etc.

No Counter tops with arborite or laminates

Bushes/raspberry canes etc. In household pit

Aluminum Pile

Clean aluminum only (yard lights must have bulbs & plastic housing removed.)

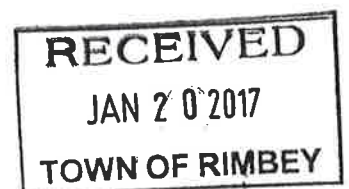
Radiators

Tires

Car, truck, tractor, quad/UTV & bike tires.

Seperate pile for tires w/ rims

Tires only, No tubes, skidoo tracks, belting, etc.



Metal Pile

****No small metals! (tin cans, welding rods, nails/screws, bolts etc. These go in the household pit)**

Larger Metals (No bigger than 6-8ft in length)

BBQ's (must be cleaned out & empty)

Sheet Metals

Large Appliances (washer & dryer, older metal dishwashers, furnaces etc.)

Bicycles

Lawnmowers(all fluids, -fuels & oils- must be drained)

Auto Parts (all plastic, glass & material must be removed)

Washers & Dryers *MUST BE EMPTY*

Fridges & Freezers *MUST BE EMPTY* (If already depleted put fridge in pile, if not depleted, to the east of the metal pile)

All racks,crispers,hoses etc. must be removed & put in household pit!!

Heavy Metal Pile

Hot water Tanks

Air Tanks

Culverts

Large motors

Large rims

Helium Tanks

Clean pipe only, no coated pipe.

Heavy pipe

Fire Extinguishers

Pipe must be no longer than 6 feet in length

Chimney pipe

Wire Area- *5 piles*

No wood, twine or other materials attached to wire

Smooth Wire

Barbed Wire

Coated Wire

Metal Banding

Cable

cable should be cut in 4-8ft lengths*

Ash Pit

Cold ashes from wood stove

All burn barrel materials.

No unburnt garbage

Concrete Pit

All forms of Concrete (Concrete blocks, sidewalk blocks, brick etc.)

****No plastic, rebar, garbage etc.****

Electronics (On pallets near Oil Building)

TV's Computers Monitors Printers Microwaves

Satellite & Stereo Receivers

NEAR OFFICE

Propane Bottles (on pallets)

Household Batteries (In pail)

CFL Lightbulbs & Ballasts (In labelled barrels)

Vehicle Batteries (On pallets)

Paints

Full or part Cans/Pails of paint on pallets in Give&Take shed to the north of the pit. ***NO EMPTY CANS***

Empty cans/pails go in household pit.

Give & Take Shed

Located to the north of our main pit, we take reusable, household items in good condition for others to take. It is somewhat exposed to the weather & animals, so please, no furniture, mattresses, clothes, tv's or appliances. Feel free to add to the shed or just pop in and have a look!
