WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the roadway closed, and

WHEREAS, Council has deemed it expedient and proper to close the portion of road for the purposes of redesign and development, and

WHEREAS, notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Sections 22 and 606 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Rimbey, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That the road described as follows, and as outlined in Appendix A, be permanently closed:

PLAN 9523664

ALL THAT PORTION OF ROAD LYING WITHIN THE LIMITS OF PLAN ____

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

2. That the closed road be legally described as listed in Clause 1 or such other description as the Registrar may think fit.

AND FURTHER THAT Bylaw 854/10 is hereby rescinded and this bylaw shall take effect on the date of third and final reading.
