That the following described land has been acquired by the said Village of Rimbey as a Nuisance ground for the said Village, and the said described land is hereby declared and enacted to be a Nuisance Ground for the said Village.

All that portion of the South mast Quarter of Section Seventeen (17) Township Forty Two (42) Range Two (2) West of the Fifth Meridian in the said Province of Alberta, which lies to the East of the established road, and South of the Blindman River, containing Three (3) acres, more or less.

All filth, rubbish, manure, refuse, offal, garbage, night soil, not otherwise provided for by By\_Law or Resolution of the Council, or by Notice of the Health Officer, or Health Inspector, shall be drawn to, and deposited on said Nusiance Ground, and disposed of to the satisfaction of the Health Officer, or Health Inspector.

Any person found guilty of an infraction of this By\_Law shall beliable to the penalties provided for in By\_Law No.5, of the Village of Rimbey, being a By\_Law to provide for the enforcement of the Village By\_Laws.

WHEREAS this was discussed with the ratepayers at the annual meeting and the vote passed to have a vote on it;

WHEREAS recent legislation provides that the Council can ask
for a plebescite on any question, matter or thing, which
will give guidance as to the wishes of the ratepayers,
NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Rimbey, duly assembled;

that a plebescite be held in the Legion Hall, on Thursday, March 26th., 1964 from 10'Oclock am to 7 O'Clock in the afternoon, for a Proprietary Elector vote regarding the following proposals:

- 1. construction of a complex building to

AND WHER AS it is estimated by the Council of the said Town that the undernoted applicable grants and contributions will be received by the fown of Rimbey:

- 1. \$ 7,000.00 grant made available for swinning pool construction;
- 2. \$30. 0.00 grant from C 76 bill- Federal- based on \$20. per capita;
- 3. \$15,000.00 available from Winter Works;
- 4. \$ 2,000.00 deducted from estimated cost by the fown having excavation work done locally.

AND WHEREAS in order to construct the proposed complex it will be necessary to borrow the sum of Minety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00) on the credit of the siad Town by issuing debentures of the said Town as herein provided;

years in consecutive equal annual instalments with interest at a rate not exceeding 6 per cent (6%) per annum, payable annually;

as shown on the last revised assessment roll of the said Town amounts to \$ 1,653,430.00;

AND WHEREAS the amount of the existing debenture debt of the said Town is \$ 343,542.01 to part of which is in arrears and of the said amount the sum of \$100,363.96 is debt incurred for local improvements to the extent to which the amounts are secured by special assessments and the sum of \$242,678.25 is debt incurred on behald of the purchase, construction, maintenance and improvement of public utilities;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RICERY IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The Municipal Council of the Town of Rimbey is hereby empowered and authorized to enter into contracts for the purpose of construction of the complex building for a Town office, Police office and colls, 2 bay Mire hall, Wetoka Health Unit office, Library and Swimming Pool as may be necessary.
- 2. That for the purposes aforesaid the sum of Ninety Thousand Dollars, (\$90,000.00) be borrowed by way of debenture on the credit and security of the Town of Rimbey at large;
- 3. The debentures to be issued under this by-law shall be for the said sum
- of Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00) shall be in denominations of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or any multiple thereof, shall be dated the 15th day of October, 1965 or upon such other day as may be appropriate having regard to the date of the borrowing of the money, shall be payable in twenty-five (15) consecutive annual instalments or principal
- on the 15th day of October in each of the years 1965 to 1939 (inclusive) or on such other day in each year as may be appropriate having reg rd to the date of the borrowing in such manner that the principal and interest will be combined and be made payable in, as nearly as possible, equal annual instalments during the said twenty-five (25) years.
- 4. The debentures maturing in each of such years shall bear interest during the currency of the debentures, at a rute not exceeding six percent (6%) per annum, payable annually on the 15th day of October in each year, or on such other day in each year as may be appropriate having regard to the date of the borrowing, and shall have coupons attached thereto for the payment of principal and interest.
- 5. The debentures with coupons thereto attached shall be payable in lawful money of Canada at the Bank of Montreal in the Town of Rimbey, and at such of manches of the said bank as may be appropriate.
- 6. The said debentures shall be signed by the Mayor and the Secretary.

  Treasurer of the Town of Rimbey and the Secretary Treasurer shall affix thereto the corporate Seal of the said Town.
- 7. The coupons attached to the said debentures shall be signed by the Mayor and the Secretary Treasurer of the Town of Rimbey and such signatures may be engraved or lithographed.
- 8. There shall be levied and raised in each year of the currency of the debentures hereby authorized, by a rate or rates sufficient therefor, on

on the assessed value of all lands and improvements shown on the assessment roll an annual tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest falling due in such year on such debantures. The said rates are collectible at the same time and in the same manner as rates and taxes.

- 10. This by-law shall take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
