WEST OF RIMBEY

Carolyn Rallison – From the 4-way stop in Rimbey, travel West on HWY 53 for 13 KM to RR40, turn right (North) and travel 6.4 KM to TWP 432, turn left (West) travel 4.5 KM, and watch for Blue Sign # 42069 on your left. A vast garden full of perennials, trees, and shrubs. Over 100 Hostas, handmade willow furniture, and feature ponds. Expect to spend at least an hour here and note that it is difficult to navigate all of it for persons with mobility issues.

IN THE TOWN OF RIMBEY

Iren Wilson & John Salomons – 5103 – 51 Avenue. From downtown Rimbey's 4-way stop, go north one block, and turn left (West) on 51 Ave. A beautiful & eye-catching display of garden décor and container gardening. A small garden with a huge visual impact. Please view from outside the white fence.

Sonja VanMoed – 5102 – 51 Avenue (Corner Lot). From downtown Rimbey's 4-way stop, go north one block, and turn left (West) on 51 Ave. Low maintenance plantings and landscape design intended to be drought tolerant and retain moisture: perennials, shrubs, junipers, and a Micro Clover lawn.

Teunisje & Richard Damer – 5105 – 45 Avenue. From downtown Rimbey's 4-way stop, go south, and turn right (West) on 45 Ave. On the corner directly across from the Outreach school. The rear of the home faces the soccer fields. Creative landscape design to maximize appeal, with feature trees, shrubs, perennials, and selective annuals. Feel free to walk through the property.

Lorraine Morris & Kirt Salomons – From the 4-way stop in downtown Rimbey, east to Buist Motors. Across from Buist Motors (South), take the gravel road. First acreage on your left (East). Brown house with white trim. Rock and concrete curbing produces very low maintenance in the front yard. Mature trees, shrubs, and perennials to the rear with garden décor and water feature elements. Garden scale train town in progress with pond.

NORTH AND EAST OF RIMBEY

Darlene Went, Master Gardener – From downtown Rimbey's 4-way stop, travel North on Hwy 20/51 Street for 26 km. Turn right (East) on Secondary Road #611 and travel 19 km. The property is on the right (Southside) with Blue sign #13027. This property features fruit trees, shrubs, native plants, a vegetable garden, perennials, and Martagon lilies. The owner also grows blue oyster and wine cap mushrooms and produces Birch syrup in the spring.
