<b>Special Council Meeting Date</b>	December 1, 2015
<b>Subject</b>	Sidewalk Snow Removal – <b>SERVICE LEVEL CHANGE</b>
<b>For Public Agenda</b>	Public Information
<b>Background</b>	Earlier this year, the Sidewalk Snow Removal was deleted from the budget due to excessive cost of the service and the Service Level was reduced.
<b>Discussion</b>	It has been a request from a delegation to Council to have the sidewalk cleaned from the Pool east to Highway 20(Kansas Ridge Estates). Administration wants to provide Council with all the potential challenges this may incur because Kansas Ridge Estates is a private condominium Board, as well Council made a resolution to provide sidewalk service from Kansas Ridge 1 & 2 to the Bank of Montreal corner and this is the genesis for this delegation.
<b>Relevant Policy/Legislation</b>	Town of Rimbey Snow Removal Policy 3101, Motion 393/15
<b>Options/Consequences</b>	Should Council resolve to continue the current service level, the policy and Bylaw will stand as written. Should Council resolve to enhance the current service level, the policy and Bylaw will need to be resolved.
<b>Desired Outcome(s)</b>	Administration recommends that we continue to adhere to the Policy and the current Bylaw.
<b>Financial Implications</b>	Increasing the service levels to all sidewalks will cost the Town approximately \$39,000.00 per season. This cost does not include any contractor costs incurred due to machine failure. The current sweeping tractor is not a commercial/industrial machine and is not designed for the workload we anticipate. This cost does not reflect any cost associated with replacement of existing equipment.
<b>Follow Up</b>	Upon resolution or direction, Administration will provide the policy change, service level change, budget change, or maintain status quo.
